PIONEERS SOUND IN THE FAITH ACCORDING TO OUR FOUNDATIONAL TEACHINGS AS DEPICTED ON THE HABAKKUK TABLES (1843 & 1850 CHARTS)

We are not to receive the words of those who come with a message that contradicts the special points of our faith. There are persons ready to catch up every new idea. The prophecies of Daniel and the Revelation are misinterpreted. These persons do not consider that the truth has been set forth at the appointed time by the very men whom God was leading to do this special work. These men followed on step by step in the very fulfillment of prophecy, and those who have not had a personal experience in this work, are to take the Word of God and believe on "their word" who have been led by the Lord in the proclamation of the first, second, and third angels' messages. {2SM 111.2}

The record of the experience through which the people of God passed in the early history of our work must be republished. Many of those who have since come into the truth are ignorant of the way in which the Lord wrought. The experience of William Miller and his associates, of Captain Joseph Bates, and of other pioneers in the Advent message, should be kept before our people (CW 145.2) 1903

The Center For Adventist Research Andrews University wrote an article about <u>Brother Simpson</u> and states his <u>tag line</u> for evangelistic meetings <u>was Habakkuk 2:2!</u> <u>Simpson taught everything</u> on the Tables of Habakkuk (charts), which would also include the <u>5th and 6th trumpets depicted on the 1843 and 1850 charts!</u>

"Simpson took the Habakkuk 2:2 bible text as his tag line "Write the vision, and make it plain upon tables, that he may run that readeth it." His special emphasis on prophecy and his desire to make it easy for people to understand kept him innovating methods to reach people with the prophetic message. In his teaching, <u>Elder Simpson</u> showed that <u>the Spirit of prophecy has an important part to act</u> in the establishment of the truth. When binding off his work, he called for me to go to Oakland to speak to the people. {Lt400-1906.10}

What does the prophet Habakkuk say we should do when we are argued with regarding these time prophecies? Take them to the tables (1843 and 1850 charts!) This is exactly what Brother Simpson did in his evangelistic meetings!



On one occasion, when meditating <u>concerning the future</u>, he (Habakkuk) said, "I will stand upon my watch, and set me upon the tower, and will watch to see what He will say unto me." Graciously the Lord answered him: "Write the vision, and make it plain upon <u>tables</u>, that he may run that readeth it. For the vision is yet for an appointed time, but at the end it shall speak, and not lie: though it tarry, wait for it; because it will surely come, it will not tarry. Behold, his soul which is lifted up is not upright in him: but the just shall live by his faith." Habakkuk 2:1-4. {PK 386.2}

The burden of this prophesy is time, concerning which, there has been true, and false visions. The true vision (or light) on time, was written on the Chart, or table. - Hab.2:2. God approved of the proclamation of 1843, and the 10th day of the 7th month 1844: by the pouring out of the Holy Ghost. Since the 7th month 1844, the "rebellious house" of Israel, have been removing the "land-marks," and writing, and proclaiming false visions; but we all know that it has been the work of man, and not of God. These flattering divinings, have cheered on the "rebellious house" of Israel to some extent; but the work has not had the holy, sanctifying influence, as when God's hand was in the work on time. {1847 JW, WLF 5.9}

If we reject <u>any</u> of the messages on Habakkuk's tables, we are rejecting the 3rd angel's message since it is justification by faith in verity! We have to <u>exercise faith</u> that the charts are credible and were directed by the hand of the Lord. <u>Brother Simpson believed in the charts since Habakkuk 2:2 (the charts) was his tag line as shown in the bottom of this photo:</u>

At Andrews University one can view Simpson's paper-mâché beasts



In presenting before the people the prophecies of Daniel and Revelation, Brother Simpson illustrates them by large images of the beasts of these prophecies; and this is creating a wonderful interest. He uses the Bible to prove every statement he makes and tells the people if they have any controversy with the truth he is teaching, their controversy must be with the Bible itself. This method of making the bible prove the Bible makes a deep impression on the minds of those assembled. The Lord is impressing many minds. {Lt368-1906.3}

Why cannot we have more men who will find their way into the very citadel of the souls of the people? Our advice was asked. We told them to respond, for these names came not in this petition from Seventh-day Adventists, but from the citizens of Los Angeles. It seems that soon we shall have the stirring scenes of 1842-43 and '44 in these cities. The warning has come: Nothing is to be allowed to come in that will disturb the foundation of the faith upon which we have been building ever since the message came in 1842, 1843, and 1844. I was in this message, and ever since I have been standing before the world, true to the light that God has given us. We do not propose to take our feet off the platform on which they were placed as day by day we sought the Lord with earnest prayer, seeking for light. Do you think that I could give up the light that God has given me? It is to be as the Rock of Ages. It has been guiding me ever since it was given. Brethren and sisters, God lives and reigns and works today. His hand is on the wheel, and in His providence He is turning the wheel in accordance with His own will. Let not men fasten themselves to documents, saying what they will do and what they will not do. Let them fasten themselves to the Lord God of heaven. Then the light of heaven will shine into the soul-temple, and we shall see the salvation of God. {GCB, April 6, 1903 par. 35}


In reviewing our past history, having traveled over <u>every step</u> of advance to our present standing, I can say, Praise God! As I see what God has wrought, I am filled with astonishment, and with confidence in Christ as leader We have nothing to fear for the future, except as <u>we shall forget</u> the way the Lord has led us, and His teaching in our past history. {LS 196.2}

So, I saw, that those who had no experience in the <u>first</u> and second angels' <u>messages</u> <u>must receive</u> them <u>from those who had an experience</u>, and followed down through the messages. <u>As JESUS was crucified</u>, <u>so I saw that these messages have been crucified</u>. And as the disciples declared that there was salvation in no other name under heaven, given among men; so, also, should the servants of GOD faithfully and fearlessly declare <u>that those who embrace but a part of the truths connected with the third message must gladly embrace the first, second and third messages as GOD has given them, or have no part nor lot in the matter. p. 75, Para. 1, [GC58].</u>

Men may get up scheme after scheme, and the enemy will seek to seduce souls from the truth, but all who believe that the Lord has spoken through Sister White, and has given her a message, will be safe from the many delusions that will come in these last days." {3SM 83.5} 1906 Lt50-1906 (January 30, 1906) [This letter was written to Brother Simpson who was "sound on every point of our faith". {Lt311-1904.13}]

We cannot believe only a part of the charts of Habakkuk that are connected with the three angel's messages. We have to believe by faith that God's hand directed the accuracy of those charts. We also have history to show the validity of these prophecies.

How do we know what Simpson taught regarding the King of the North in Daniel 11:45 based on his notations in his Bible? Since <u>Daniel 11:3-5</u> tells us the specifications that determine who is the king of the north based on the division of Alexander's kingdom, we can determine who is the king of the north by <u>who occupies that geographical location</u>, and this we can see by Simpson's notes in his Bible- that he recognized Alexander's four generals as occupying that territory- Lysimachus, Cassander, Selucid and Ptolomy.

Simpson's chart below shows that the little horn came out of Macedonia which would be under Alexander's general, **Cassande**r who had Greece and the neighboring countries in the **West**. Cassander was very soon conquered by **Lysimichus** (who had Asia Minor in the **North**), and his kingdom, Greece and Macedon, annexed to Thrace. And **Lysimichus was in turn conquered** by **Seleucus** (who had Syria and Babylon in the **East**) and Macedon and Thrace annexed to Syria. **So the Selucid kingdom became the king of the North**. And **Ptolomy** (who had Egypt in the South) remained as the king of the South. So Alexander's kingdom resolved itself into two divisions: **king of**North and king of South. Whoever occupies that territory (relative to Jerusalem), is the king of that region. **Today Turkey occupies** (since 1453) the prior **Selucid territory in the north** and Egypt today still occupies the territory of the South.



And a mighty king shall stand up, that shall rule with great dominion, and do according to his will. And when he shall stand up, his kingdom shall be broken, and shall be divided toward the four winds of heaven; and not to his posterity, nor according to his dominion which he ruled: for his kingdom shall be plucked up, even for others beside those. Dan 11:3-4

Xerxes was the last Persian king to invade Greece; and now the prophecy passes over six minor rulers to introduce the "mighty king", Alexander the Great. After overthrowing the Persian Empire, Alexander became absolute lord of the greater portion of the then-known habitable world. A few years after his death, the kingdom was torn into four parts; which then became four kingdoms. These four divisions were the four horns of the "he goat" that grew up after the breaking off the first horn. That first horn was Alexander the Great. The four kings sprung up after his death and divided the empire between them (divisions dissolving into northern and southern territories), according to the four winds of heaven, four points of the compass. In brief, the biblical record concerns itself primarily with only two of the four, the kingdom of the north and the kingdom of the south.

And the king of the south shall be strong, and one of his princes; and he shall be strong above him, and have dominion; his dominion shall be a great dominion. Dan 11:5

Since the king of the north and the king of the south are many times referred to in the rest of this chapter it is essential to an understanding of the prophecy to identify these powers clearly. The four winds of heaven are the four kingdoms following Alexander the Greats death. Whatever changes in national boundaries might occur in the coming years, these first four divisions of Alexander's empire determine the kingdom the north or the kingdom of the south. Otherwise, we have no standard by which to test the application of the prophecy. Alexander's empire eventually resolved itself into only two divisions, north and south. These two divisions then are the primary focus of Daniels prophecy.

The prophecy states the **king of the south, Egypt**, shall be strong. Egypt became one part of the original four kingdoms and this kingdom was made strong. The <u>king of the north</u> ("one of his princes" in verse five) <u>became a union of the remaining three parts</u>. Thus, this king of the north <u>became a more powerful kingdom than that of Egypt in the south</u>. The king of the north, at this time, may be referred to as "Syria", a large kingdom. From this came the Ottoman Empire and today we know it as Turkey, of course, greatly reduced in size from the original Empire.

Our camp meetings of the past included selling/ displaying prophetic charts. This appears to be possibly one of Brother Simpson's charts at a 1912 camp meeting hanging above?



It was the <u>united testimony</u> of Second Advent lecturers and papers, <u>when standing on 'the original faith,</u>' that the <u>publication of the chart was a fulfillment of Habakkuk 2:2, 3.</u> — 6BIO 255.5.

Our ministers are not doing their whole duty. The attention of the people should be called to the momentous event which is so near at hand. The signs of the times should be kept fresh before their minds. The prophetic visions of Daniel and John foretell a period of moral darkness and declension; but at the time of the end, the ime in which we are now living, the vision [Habakkuk's prophecy!] was to speak and not lie. When the signs predicted begin to come to pass, the waiting, watching ones are bidden to look up and lift up their heads and rejoice because their redemption draweth nigh. {5T 9.2}
