In connection with his message the call is heard, `Come out of her My people.' As these warnings join the third angel's message, it swells to a loud cry." <u>Spirit of Prophecy</u>, vol 4, p 422.

"The messenger turned to the congregation and said, `Do you believe the prophecies? Do you who know the truth, understand that the last message of warning is now being given to the world,--the last call of mercy is now being heard? Do you believe that Satan has come down with great power, working with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in every place?
