## Chapter 12

12:1 And there appeared a great wonder in heaven; a woman [true church- Eze 23:2-4; Rev 17:3-6, 15, 18] clothed with the sun [light & glory of the gospel dispensation], and the moon [Mosaic dispensation] under her feet, and upon her head a crown of twelve stars [12 apostles- Luke 2:25, 26, 38]:

12:2 And she being with child cried, travailing in birth, and pained to be delivered.

12:3 And there appeared another wonder in heaven; and behold a great red dragon [Pagan Rome], having seven heads and ten horns, and seven crowns upon his heads.

12:4 his tail drew the third part of the stars of heaven, and did cast them to the earth: and the <u>dragon [Herod-Matt 2:1, 12, 13, 16; Isa 7:16 "in the removing of the kings" SNH SSP 215; Mat 2:22]</u> stood before the woman which was ready to be delivered, for to devour her child as soon as it was born. Jer 31:15, 16: Isa 9:6; Matt 2:16-18]

12:5 And she brought forth a man child, [Jesus- Eph 1:20, 21; Heb 8:1; Rev 3:21] who was to rule all nations with a rod of iron [Ps 2:7-9]: and her child was caught up unto God, and [to] his throne.

12:6 And the woman [Jer 3:14; Hos 2:19; Eph 5: 23-32] fled into the wilderness, where she hath a place prepared of God, that they should feed her there a thousand two hundred [and] threescore days [For 1260 years, the church was nourished by the Word of God & the ministration of angles. A day for a year: Num 14:34; Eze 4:6].

12:7 And there was war in heaven: Michael [Christ-Jude 9; 1Thess 4:16; John 5:28, 29] and his angels fought against the dragon [Pagan Rome]; and the dragon fought and his angels,

12:8 And prevailed not; neither was their place found any more in heaven [DAR 409-10].

12:9 And the great dragon [Satan- Rev 13:1] was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and Satan, which deceiveth the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him.

12:10 [After the cross] And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of his Christ: for the accuser of our brethren [Satan] is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night.

12:11 And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death.

## The Woman and The Dragon/ 1260 years

**Verse 1:** Jesus, while on earth, waged a warfare and obtained the victory. See verse 13 1SG 79.2

#### Verse 3

The opposing power of Satan embodied in the ruling monarchy of earth – the empire of Rome, with Caesar Augustus at its head.

Dragon working through Herod (pagan Rome) to destroy baby Jesus as soon as he was born.



#### Women (Church) in the Wilderness



Verses 9-17: Satan, personally, is the chief agent

12:12 Therefore rejoice, [ye] heavens, and ye that dwell in them. <u>Woe</u> to the inhabiters of the earth and of the sea! for the devil [Satan] is come down unto you, having great wrath, because he knoweth that he hath but a short time.

12:13 And when the dragon [Satan] saw that he was cast unto the earth, he <u>persecuted the woman</u> [for 1260 years] which brought forth the man [child] [Christ].

12:14 And to the <u>woman [true church]</u> were given <u>two wings</u> of a great eagle [Ex 19:4], that she might fly into the wilderness, into her place, where she is nourished for a time, and times, and half a time [1260 years- Dan 7:25; Rev 12:6], from the face of the serpent [Satan].

12:15 And the serpent [Satan] cast out of his mouth water as a flood [A flood of iniquity, of false teachings, of persecutions, in the East, this flood was "smoke" from the "bottomless pit" in the form of Mohammedanism; in the West, it was the papacy.] after the woman, that he might cause her to be carried away of the flood.

12:16 And the earth [Alps- The 16th century began the Reformation] helped the woman [true church], and the earth opened her mouth, and swallowed up the flood which the dragon [Satan] cast out of his mouth.

[The last generation of Christians will experience the wrath of Satan]

12:17 And the dragon [Satan] was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with the remnant [individuals which constitute the true church] of her seed, which keep the commandments of God, and have the testimony of Jesus Christ.

**Verse 13:** The "<u>mystery of godliness</u>" was God manifested here as a man; the "<u>mystery of iniquity</u>" was a man pretending to be God.



- 1 And there appeared a great wonder in heaven; a woman clothed with the sun, and the moon under her feet, and upon her head a crown of twelve stars:
- 2 And she being with child cried, travailing in birth, and pained to be delivered.
- 3 And there appeared another wonder in heaven; and behold a great red dragon, having seven heads and ten horns, and seven crowns upon his heads.

"A woman", signifies Gods church, 2 Corinthians 11:2. A corrupt woman represents an apostate or corrupt church, Ezekiel 23:2-4. A pure woman, as in this instance, represents the true church. "The sun" here signifies the light and glory of the gospel era. "The moon" is the symbol of the Mosaic period (the Old Testament era). As the moon shines with light reflected from the sun, so the Old Testament era shines from the light of the New Testament gospel era. Revelation 21:5. "A crown of twelve stars" symbolizes the twelve apostles. "A great red dragon" represents pagan Rome. "Heaven" is the area of the sun, moon and stars, that region we typically speak of as "heaven". The scenes presented to John in this part of his vision occur here on this earth, not the place where God resides, in literal heaven.

Verses 1 and 2 cover a period of time beginning just before the opening of the Christian era, when the church was earnestly longing for and expecting the advent of the Messiah, and extending to the full establishment of the gospel church; with its crown of twelve apostles, Luke 2:25-26.

The woman (the church), had the moon under her feet; that is, the Mosaic period had just ended and she is now clothed with the light of the gospel sun; light that was just dawning. By looking forward the church is represented as fully organized with its twelve apostles, being established immediately after Christ began His ministry. There is no ground for misunderstanding the passage, and hence, no violence is done to a correct system of interpretation by this representation.

4 And his tail drew the third part of the stars of heaven, and did c ast them to the earth: and the dragon stood before the woman which was ready to be delivered, for to devour her child as soon as it was born.

5 And she brought forth a man child, who was to rule all nations with a rod of iron: and her child was caught up unto God, and to His throne.

6 And the woman fled into the wilderness, where she hath a place prepared of God that they should feed her there a thousand two hundred and threescore days.

"A third part of the stars" is applied in two ways by John. The sun, moon and stars are sometimes used as symbols to represent leaders, as we have already had evidence in



Revelation 8:12. Judea had three classes of rulers: kings, priests, and the Sanhedrin. When Judea became a Roman province, prior to the birth of the Messiah, Rome forced the removal of a third of its rulers, the kings.

The stars undoubtedly have a wider, or secondary, meaning as well; relating to verses 7-9 of this chapter. As a result of a conflict, literally in heaven, it is evident that a third part of the angelic host, who joined with Satan in his rebellion against the Ruler of the universe, were cast out of the courts of glory.


"The dragon stood before the woman", ready to devour her child, the Messiah. The testimony concerning the "man child", which the dragon sought to destroy, is applicable only to our Lord Jesus Christ. No other has been "caught up unto God and to His throne" and been exalted as

Jesus was, Ephesians 1:20-21; Hebrews 8:1; Revelation 3:21. No other received from God the commission to rule all nations with a rod of iron, only Jesus has been appointed to this work, Psalm 2:7-9. The time to which the prophecy refers is equally evident, being the time when Christ appeared in this world as a babe in Bethlehem.

The dragon represents Herod specifically, pagan Rome and the devil behind the power of Rome secondarily. It was Herod who made fiendish efforts to destroy the infant, Jesus when he decreed that all the male children in Bethlehem from two years old and under should be slain. Rome was the most responsible actor in this event. We have then the most conclusive evidence that pagan Rome, in the person of Herod, is the great red dragon of verse 4. It was Rome who cast down a third of the Jewish leadership, its kings, and it was pagan Rome who attempted to devour the woman's man-child.



The Christ child is born to the waiting and watching church. Herod could not destroy Him, nor could the combined powers of earth and hell overcome Him. He broke the cruel bands of death and the tomb and opened a way of life for mankind. He was caught up unto God and His throne when He ascended to heaven in the sight of His disciples, leaving to them and us the promise that He would come again.



The church fled into the wilderness to hide from persecution at the time the papacy was firmly established, in 538 AD. There it was nourished by the word of God, that is, His two witness the Old and New Testaments; and the ministration of angels during the long, dark and bloody rule of the papacy power for the next 1,260 years. This civil/religious papal power of Rome ruling from 538 to 1798, ended when it received a deadly wound. Said wound was the removal of its authority to

persecute anyone it deemed a "heretic".

7 And there was war in heaven: Michael and His angels fought against the dragon; and the dragon fought and his angels,

8 and prevailed not; neither was their place found any more in heaven.

9 And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and Satan, which deceiveth the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him.

10 And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of His Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night.

11 And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death.

12 Therefore rejoice, you heavens, and you that dwell in them. Woe to the inhabiters of the earth and of the sea! For the devil is come down unto you, having great wrath, because he knows that he hath but a short time.

The first six verses of this chapter take us down to the close of the 1260 years in 1798, which marked the end of papal supremacy. Now in the 7th verse, we are carried back to the time of Christ's first advent when pagan Rome sought to destroy Him; and even farther back to the beginning of the great controversy between righteousness and evil. When in literal heaven Michael (Christ) and His angels fought against the dragon (Satan) and his angels. We see that Michael is Christ from the scriptures found in Jude 9:1; Thessalonians 4:16; John 5:28-29.

Centuries later, "the great dragon", "that old serpent called the devil, and Satan", put forth a supreme effort in pagan Rome, to destroy the world's Redeemer. Satan had looked forward to Christ's mission to this earth as his last chance of success in overthrowing the plan of salvation. He came to Christ with carefully planned temptations, in the hope of overcoming Him. He tried in

various ways to destroy Christ during His ministry. When he had succeeded in laying Him in the tomb, he tried to hold Him there. But in every encounter the Son of God was triumphant; and He sends back His gracious promise to His faithful followers: "To him that overcometh will I grant to sit with Me in My throne, even as I also overcame, and am set down with My Father in His throne", Revelation 3:21.

Satan and the fallen angels had suffered a terrible defeat, which Christ describes by saying, "I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven", Luke 10:18, and Peter tells us that these fallen angels have been delivered "into chains of darkness to be reserved unto judgment", 2Peter 2:4. Because he could not conquer Christ, in heaven, he turns his wrath against the church (the woman) which becomes the object of his malice and his rage. Now the prophet glances rapidly over the working of Satan from the time of his original rebellion in heaven to the end, verses 11 and 12. During which time the faithful brethren overcome him by the blood of



the Lamb and the word of their testimony, while his wrath increases as his time grows short. It was Satan that moved upon Herod to put the Savior to death. It is always Satan that stands behind evil deeds. The chief agent of the arch rebel in the early Christian era was the Roman Empire, whose dominant religion was pagan. Thus, while the dragon represents Satan, in a secondary sense it represents pagan Rome.


- 13 And when the dragon saw that he was cast unto the earth, he persecuted the woman which brought forth the man-child.
- 14 And to the woman were given two wings of a great eagle, that she might fly into the wilderness, into her place, where she is nourished for a time, and times, and half a time, from the face of the serpent.
- 15 And the serpent cast out of his mouth water as a flood after the woman, that he might cause her to be carried away of the flood.
- 16 And the earth helped the woman, and the earth opened her mouth, and swallowed up the flood which the dragon cast out of his mouth. 17 And the dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with the remnant of her seed, which keep the commandments of God, and have the testimony of Jesus Christ.

When Satan becomes fully aware of his failure to defeat Christ in heaven, his fury is increased tenfold. He turns his wrath upon the church which Christ established and it is forced into hiding, that is, into "the wilderness". Christ's new church was first persecuted by pagan Rome and then this continued when the head of Rome became Papal in 538 AD. The persecution continued from that point for the next 1260 years. It was only when papal Rome lost its power to "correct heretics", in 1798 when the pope was taken captive and the church received a deadly wound, did the persecution subside.

The "mystery of godliness" was God made manifest as a man, Jesus Christ; the "mystery of iniquity" was a man pretending to be God, the pope of Roman Catholicism. Catholicism is the great apostasy produced by the union of paganism and false Christianity, as Catholicism is simply paganism baptized. Christ's church, forced into seclusion, continued worshiping in secret places. The caves and the hidden recesses of the valleys of the Piedmont, which borders France and Italy, are representative of such places. Here the truth of the gospel was sacredly cherished from the rage of its foes. Here God watched over His church, and by His providence protected and nourished her.

The eagles' wings given her appropriately signify the haste with which Christ's church was obliged to flee when the man of sin was installed in power. This figure, eagles wings, was also used to describe ancient Israel, "Ye have seen what I did unto the Egyptians and how I bare you on eagles' wings and brought you unto Myself", Exodus 19:4.

The period of time during which the woman is nourished in the wilderness is given as "a time and times and half a time". This is similar phraseology to that used in Daniel 7:25 and furnishes a key for the explanation of verse 14. The same period is called in Revelation 12:6, "a thousand two hundred and threescore days". From this we know that a "time" is one year, 360 days (reckoned



as a biblical year); two "times", two years, or 720 days; and "half a time", half a year, or 180 days, making in all 1260 days. These days, being symbolic, then signify 1,260 literal years.

The serpent cast out of his mouth water as a flood to carry away Christ's church. The flood was the many false doctrines of the papacy, which had so corrupted all nations as to have absolute control over the civil/military powers for long centuries. Millions of true believers were carried away by that flood of error, but the church was not entirely swallowed up, for the days were shortened for the elect's sake, Matthew 24:22.

"The earth helped the woman" by opening its mouth and swallowing up the flood; this is when the Protestant Reformation of the sixteenth century began its work. Martin Luther and his co-laborers would expose the true character of the papacy, and break the power of superstition that had enslaved the minds of the people. Princes began to support the cause of the Reformers, it was the dawning of religious light and liberty, and God would not suffer the darkness to swallow up its radiance. To the present day, the spirit of the Reformation and religious liberty has been fostered by the leading nations of Christendom.

But the dragon is not yet through with his work, verse 17 brings to view another and a final outburst of his wrath, this time against the last generation of Christians to live on the earth. That time in which we live today! No generation but the last can be represented by the remnant. This intense warfare against the truth cannot be far in the future.

This remnant is characterized by its keeping of the commandments of God and having the testimony of Jesus Christ. This point speaks to a Sabbath reform to be accomplished in the last days. It is the Sabbath primarily that in the commandments we find a difference of faith and practice among those who accept the Decalogue as Gods eternal moral law and those who proclaim His law has either been set aside or accepted the change of "times and laws" enacted by Roman Catholicism. This is more particularly brought to view in the message of Revelation 14:9-12.

No symbols more fitting and impressive could be found than are here employed. The Mosaic dispensation shone with a light borrowed from the Christian dispensation, just as the moon shines with light borrowed from the sun. The woman, the church, had the moon under her feet; that is, the mosaic dispensation had just ended, and the woman was clothed with the light of the gospel sun, which had just risen. By the figure of the prolepsis, the church is represented as fully organized, with its twelve apostles, before the manchild, Christ, appeared upon the scene. This is easily accounted for by the fact that it was to be thus constituted immediately after Christ should commence His ministry; and He is more especially connected with this church than with that of the former dispensation. There is no ground for any misunderstanding of the passage; and hence no violence is done to a correct system of interpretation by this representation.
