Chapter 11

This chapter goes back to the Western Empire, and shows what was going on in that part of the world during the time that the Turkish Empire was making history in the eastern division. The barbarians in 476 left Rome in a divided state-10 tribes had settled within the borders of the Western Empire. Three were plucked up in 538 (Dan 7:8). But from the other 7, developed the nations of Europe which are in existence today.

11:1 And there was given me a reed like unto <u>a rod</u> [by 10 commandment standard]: and the angel stood, saying, <u>Rise</u>, and measure the temple of <u>God</u> [to give subject of sanctuary a special examination], and the altar, and <u>them</u> [worshipers of the true church on earth] that worship therein.

11:2 But the court which is without the temple leave out, and measure it not; for it is given unto the Gentiles [those who know not God; Dan 7:25]: and the holy city shall they tread under foot forty [and] two months [1260 years; 538 AD-1798 AD- Dan 11:30-35].

11:3 And I will give [power] unto my two witnesses [Old and New Testaments], and they shall prophesy a thousand two hundred [and] threescore days [1260 years], clothed in sackcloth [obscurity. The Reformation removed sackcloth Rev 1:20].

11:4 These are the two olive trees [The Word of God/ Old & New Testament- Zech4:11-14], and the two candlesticks [Word gives light] standing before the God of the earth.

11:5 And if any man will hurt [to hurt the Word of God is to oppose, corrupt, or pervert its testimony & turn people away from it; judgment pronounced on such] https://www.nummers.com/html [Old & New Testament], fire judgment pronounced on such] them judgment fire: Judgment of fire: Mal 4:1; Rev 20:15; 22:18, 19] proceedeth out of their mouth, and devoureth their enemies: and if any man will hurt them [Old & New Testament], he must in this manner be killed.

11:6 <u>These</u> [Old & New Testament] have power to shut heaven, that it rain not in the days of their prophecy: and have power over waters to turn them to blood, and to smite the earth with all <u>plagues</u> [wrath of God/ 7 last plagues], as often as they will.


11:7 And when they shall have finished their testimony [1798], the beast [atheistic Homosexual France] that ascendeth out of the bottomless pit [comes out of nowhere] shall make war against them, and shall overcome them, and kill them.

11:8 And their dead bodies [shall lie] in the street [a plot was laid by France to destroy all the pious Huguenots; and in one night (Aug 24/25, 1572- St Bartholomew's Massacre) 50,000 of them were murdered in cold blood] of the great city



Two Witnesses, Seventh Trumpet/ 3rd Woe, The Temple, The Coming Kingdom

Verses 11:1-13 mirrors Dan 11:36-39 and are a series of events which would take place near or in the times of the first, second and third angel's messages of Rev 14, ie. the French Revolution removing the authority of the Pope in 1798 and the end of the 2300 year prophecy in 1844.



THE CHURCH IS A GOLDEN CANDLESTICK [ZECH 4: 2, 3]



Bowl of Oil- The oil of grace, The Truth of God

Life flows through the Old and New Testament (Isa 55:11) into the Common Bowl where unity among saints exists.

The purity of the oil they burn is represented by the close connection with these living trees. When connection with these living trees is severed, spiritual death is the result.

Verse 8: St. Bartholomew's Massacre

[France], which spiritually is called Sodom and Egypt [Ex:2], where also our Lord was crucified ["CRUSH THE WRETCH" was the infidel's motto].

- 11:9 And they of the people and kindreds and tongues and nations shall see their dead bodies three days and an half [3½ years], and shall not suffer their dead bodies to be put in graves [bodies thrown into the river].
- 11:10 And they that dwell upon the earth <u>shall rejoice over</u> them, and make merry, and shall send gifts one to another; because these two prophets [Bible] tormented them that dwelt on the earth.
- 11:11 And after three days and an half the Spirit of life from God entered into them [Decree passed in November 1793 against the Bible was reversed in June 1797, 3 ½ years later], and they stood upon their feet; and great fear fell upon them which saw them.
- 11:12 And they heard a great voice from heaven saying unto them, Come up hither. And they <u>ascended up to heaven in a cloud [heavenly elevation- Dan 4:22]</u>; and their enemies beheld them. [Circulation of the Bible: 1804 British Bible Society, 1817 American Society]
- 11:13 And the same hour was there <u>a great earthquake</u>, and the tenth part of the city fell [France, one of the ten horns/1/10th], and in the earthquake were <u>slain of men seven thousand</u> [French Revolution of 1789-1798]: and the remnant were affrighted, and gave glory to the God of heaven. [Papal Roman Power- 10 horns of Dan 7:24]

THIRD WOE/ SEVENTH TRUMPET

11:14 The second woe is past [Turkey, Aug 11, 1840]; [and], behold, the third woe cometh [between the 6th and 7th trumpets is a short interval; and in this interval the loud cry of the mighty angel (Rev 14) was given] quickly [commenced 1840-1844]. [1897 UrS, DAR 505; GC 334.4-335.1] [In 1844 the 7th trumpet began to sound when prophetic time was at an end, that is, 1844. In 1844, the antitypical Day of Atonement was begun in the heavenly sanctuary and investigative judgment began.]

- 11:15 And the seventh angel sounded [In 1844 the heavenly sanctuary understanding was opened to view and the mystery of God in Rev 10:7]; and there were great voices in heaven, saying, The kingdoms of this world are become [the kingdoms] of our Lord, and of his Christ; and he shall reign for ever and ever. [Day of Atonement: Lev 16:2, 29, 30; Heb 9:3, 7; Dan 8:14, 26]
- 11:16 And the <u>four and twenty elders</u>, <u>which sat before God</u> <u>on their seats</u>, <u>fell upon their faces</u>, <u>and worshipped God</u>,
- 11:17 Saying, We give thee thanks, O Lord God Almighty, which art, and wast, and art to come [Christ ascended to the Holy Place at his resurrection in 31 AD]; because thou hast taken to thee thy great power, and hast reigned.

Verse 9

31/2 years drought in days of Elijah demonstrates 3 ½ years (1260 years) of darkness Ja 5:17; Nahum 2:2; Matt 25:8

Verse 10:

Make merry/ rejoice: The wicked triumphed over their evil course but soon were horror-struck at the result of their own wicked deeds

France is the only nation that ever openly denied the existence of the Diety.

<u>Two prophets</u>: In **1793**, a decree was passed forbidding the Bible, they were gathered and burned. All the institutions of the Bible were abolished: the 7th day weekly rest, baptism, and communion, death was pronounced as eternal sleep, the being of God was denied. The <u>Goddess of Reason</u>, in the person of a vile woman, was set up and publically worshiped.

Three and a half years later (**Verse 11**), the Decree of 1793 was reversed due to the appalling results of the rejection of the Bible.

Verse 12: Bible Societies, early 1800's

Verse 13: French Revolution, 1789-1798 Not only the reign if papal tyranny at an end, but the power of the monarchy was shaken and the vast army of nobles (7,000) lost their titles.

- ➤ The licentiousness of Sodom in the day of Lot, was repeated in France, especially in her capital.
- ➤ The gross idolatry of Egypt, with its proverbial darkness, was to be found again in modern France.
- As the Jews, by rejecting the Word of God sent by the prophets, severed their connection with heaven and crucified their Lord, so France repeated the sin, and crucified again the Son of God.

Verses 15-17: Glances <u>forward to the full establishment of the</u> kingdom of God.

Verses 15-19: "In the days of the voice of the <u>seventh angel</u>, when he shall BEGIN to sound, the MYSTERY of GOD shall be <u>finished</u>, as he hath declared to his servants the prophets **Rev 10:7**." 1850 Chart

Verse 16:

24 elders who have long waited for the redemption of their fellow beings, fall before the throne and worship Him. They look forward to the restoration of the earth at the end of the 1,000 years.

11:18 And the <u>nations were angry</u> [commencing with the 1848 Europe Revolution. Matt 24: 7, 8; Luke 21:25, 26; ExV 24.1; 54.3-4; RH 1-28-09.3 – Time of Trouble is "a short period of time" before plagues are poured out], and thy wrath [7 last plagues] is come, and the time [Oct 22, 1844] of the dead, that they should be judged, and that thou shouldest give reward unto thy servants the prophets [possession of the heavenly inheritance at the end of the 1000 years- Matt 25:34], and to the saints, and them that fear thy name, small and great; and shouldest destroy them which destroy the earth [wicked devoured by purifying fires- 2Pet 3:7; Rev 20:9; ExV 19.1].

11:19 And the temple of God was opened in heaven, and there was seen [after the disappointment] in his temple the ark of his testament [MHP- October 22, 1844/commencement of the 7th trumpet reviewed]: and there were lightnings, and voices, and thunderings, and an earthquake, and great hail.





- 1 And there was given me a reed like unto a rod: and the angel stood, saying, Rise, and measure the temple of God, and the altar, and them that worship therein.
- 2 But the court which is without the temple leave out, and measure it not; for it is given unto the Gentiles: and the holy city shall they tread under foot forty and two months.

This chapter is a continuation of the instruction which the angel began giving to John in chapter 10; hence these verses, Revelation 11:1-14, should not be separated by the present

division into chapter 11. In the last verse of Revelation 10, we have a prophecy of the third angel's message. This message, connected with the temple of God in heaven, is designed to fit a certain class of people as worshipers. The temple here cannot the church; it is the literal temple in heaven. The worshipers are to be measured in character by the standard of a law, the Ten Commandments. This is the standard God has by which to measure "the whole duty of man". It is a part of the measuring rod given to John.

To measure any object requires that special attention be given to that object. The call to rise and measure the temple of God is a prophetic command to the church to give the subject of the temple, or sanctuary, a special examination. The Ten Commandments alone are not enough to carry out the measurement. When we take the entire message it leads to an examination of the sanctuary on high. Here, along with the commandments, we have the ministration of Christ. Hence we conclude that the measuring rod, taken as a whole, is the special message to investigate the law and the sanctuary.

John is instructed, "The court which is without the temple leave out". The attention of the church is directed to the inner temple and the service there. Matters pertaining to the outer court are of less consequence now, since it is given to the Gentiles. Spiritually speaking, in this instance, Gentiles are those who are in apostasy or fighting against Gods law. That the court refers to this earth, it is the place where the victims were slain whose blood was to be ministered inside the sanctuary, the blood of lambs, goats and such. These sacrifices were always meant to point to Jesus, the Lamb of God who would be sacrificed for the sins of the world on Calvary, in Judea. The gentiles introduced here represent the great apostasy of treading down of the holy city, Gods

Church, forty and two months; the 1,260 years of papal persecution. Thus we are carried back into the past by an easy and natural transition; now our attention is called to a new series of events.



3 And I will give power unto My two witnesses, and they shall prophesy a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.

The period of "a thousand two hundred and three score days" is variously referred to in the Scriptures. It appears in three forms:

As 1260 days in this verse and Rev. 12:6. As 42 months in Rev. 11:2 and 13:5. As 3 1/2 times in Daniel 7:25, 12:7 and Rev.12:14.

These all refer to the same period and can be easily calculated. A time is a vear, as is evident from Daniel 11:13. A year has twelve months. and a Biblical month contains thirty davs. Thus we have 1,260 years. That a biblical month has 30 days is demonstrated in the record of the flood, Genesis 7 and 8. Here we will find definite measures of time that allow for calculating the

prophetic periods, bearing in mind that in prophecy a day is equal to a year of ordinary time. For brevity's sake, we now need to move on.

During this time of 1,260 years the two witnesses are in a state of sackcloth, that is, obscurity, and God gives them power to endure and maintain their testimony through that dark and dismal period. But who are these witness'?



4 These are the two olive trees, and the two candlesticks standing before the God of the earth.

Zechariah 4:11-14, implies that the two olive trees are taken to represent the word of God. Jesus declared of the Old Testament Scriptures, "They are they which testify of Me", John 5:39. The "Two Witnesses" then are the Old and New Testaments. The essential purpose of the Scriptures is to give witness to the mercy and character of God. Our Lord commands, "Search the Scriptures . . . they are they which testify (bear witness) of Me".

This was addressed to the Jews and described the character and office of the Old Testament. The New Testament is similarly pronounced the giver of testimony: "This gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations", Matthew 24:14. These

declarations and considerations are sufficient to sustain the conclusion that the Old and New Testaments are Christ's two witnesses.

5 And if any man will hurt them, fire proceedeth out of their mouth, and devoureth their enemies: and if any man will hurt them, he must in this manner be killed.

To hurt the word of God is to oppose, corrupt or pervert its testimony, and turn people away from it. Against those who do this work, fire proceedeth out of their mouth (the mouth of the witness') to devour them, that is, judgment of fire is pronounced in the word against such. It declares that those who hurt them will have their punishment in the lake that burns with fire and brimstone; Malachi 4:1, Revelation 20:15 and 22:18-19.

6 These have power to shut heaven, that it rain not in the days of their prophecy: and have power over waters to turn them to blood, and to smite the earth with all plagues, as often as they will.

In what sense have these witnesses power to shut heaven, turn waters to blood, and bring plagues on the earth? Elijah shut heaven so that it did not rain for three years and a half, but he did so by the word of the Lord. Moses by the word of the Lord turned the waters of Egypt to blood. "As often as they will" means just as these judgments, recorded in their testimony, have been fulfilled, so every threatening and judgment pronounced by them against any people will surely come to pass. The world has yet to be smitten with the seven last plagues, but it will be, on this we have the sure word of prophecy!

7 And when they shall have finished their testimony, the beast that ascendeth out of the bottomless pit shall make war against them, and shall overcome them, and kill them.


8 And their dead bodies shall lie in the street of the great city, which spiritually is called Sodom and Egypt, where also our Lord was crucified. Revelation 11:8-13 mirrors Daniel 11:36-39

"When they shall have finished their testimony" is when the sackcloth state has ended. Matthew 24:22 expresses it as the days of persecution being shortened, that is just prior to the period of the 1,260 years termination. A 'beast' in prophecy, denotes a kingdom or power, see Daniel 7:17, 23. This kingdom/power is likened spiritually to Sodom and Egypt, which were also atheistic. In Exodus 5:2 Pharaoh said, "Who is the Lord, that I should obey His voice to let Israel go? I know not the Lord, neither will I let Israel go". Here is atheism!

The two witnesses testified in sackcloth beginning in 538 AD, with the rise of the Roman Catholic power that would persecute Gods people until its power was taken away, 1,260 years later. In 1798 France denied the being of God in her national capacity, and made war on the Monarchy of heaven, this then marks the rise of that atheistic power, likened to Sodom and Egypt.

Just prior to 1798, in the year 1793, the gospel was abolished by a solemn act of the French Legislature. Some five years later, the Roman Catholic power received its deadly wound. So the time of the two witnesses was cut short just before the prophecy terminated. The indignities offered to the actual copies of the Bible were unimportant after this; their life lay in their doctrines. With the extinction of the doctrines the bible itself was extinguished.

By the decree of the French Government, declaring that the nation acknowledged no God, the Old and New Testaments were slain throughout the limits of Republican France. The Sacred Books were destroyed in the



general plunder of every place of worship. In Lyons they were dragged at the tail of an ass in a procession through the streets. Among other events of 1793 a "Grand Festival" dedicated to "Reason and Truth" was celebrated in the Cathedral of Notre Dame, desecrated and renamed "The Temple of Reason". A pyramid was erected in the center of the Church and inscribed "To philosophy". The torch of "Truth" was on the altar of "Reason" spreading light, etc. The National Convention and all the authorities attended this burlesque and insulting ceremony.

Bibles were gathered and burned, and every possible mark of contempt heaped upon them, and all institutions of the Bible abolished; the Sabbath was blotted out, and every tenth day substituted for mirth and profanity. Baptism and the communion were abolished. It was said there was no God; and death was pronounced to be an eternal sleep. The "Goddess of Reason" was set up, in the person of a vile woman, and publicly worshiped. Surely here is the power that exactly answers the prophecy. This point will be further developed in the comments on the next verse.

9 And they of the people and kindreds and tongues and nations shall see their dead bodies three days and an half, and shall not suffer their dead bodies to be put in graves.

This verse denotes the feelings of other nations watching the outrage on the two witnesses. They would see what war infidel France had made on the Bible, but these other nations would not be led to engage in this wicked work themselves. Nor would they allow the murdered witnesses to be buried, or put out of sight among their own nations. The witnesses lay dead three



days and a half; that is three years and a half, in France only. But France attempted to arouse Christians everywhere to put forth a war against the Bible; as we will see in the next verse.

10 And they that dwell upon the earth shall rejoice over them, and make merry, and shall send gifts one to another; because these two prophets tormented them that dwelt on the earth.

This denotes the joy of those who hated the bible, for they were tormented by it. Great was the joy of infidels everywhere, for awhile. But "the triumphing of the wicked is short"; so it was in France. Their war on the Bible and Christianity had well-nigh swallowed them all up. They set out to destroy Christ's "two witnesses" but they filled France with blood and terror. So much so, that they were horror-struck at the result of their wicked deeds, and were glad to remove the bible from their wicked hands.


11 And after three days and an half the spirit of life from God entered into them, and they stood upon their feet; and great fear fell upon them which saw them.

In 1793, a decree passed the French Assembly suppressing the bible, but just three years after, a resolution was introduced into the Assembly returning respect to the Scriptures. That resolution lay on the table six months, when it was taken up and passed without a dissenting vote.

Thus, in just three years and a half, the witnesses "stood upon their feet" and great fear fell upon them which saw them. The appalling results of the rejection of the bible had driven France to take her hands off these witnesses. The Church and the bible had been slain in France from November, 1793 till June, 1797. The three years and a half expired and the bible, so long and so sternly repressed before, was once again placed in honor, and was openly the book of free Protestantism!







The two witnesses "ascended up to heaven" is an expression signifying their great exaltation. The Scriptures attained such a state of exaltation,

as here indicated, after the time France had made war upon them. Shortly after that time, the British Bible Society was organized in 1804 and there followed the American Bible Society in 1816. These, with their almost innumerable auxiliaries, were scattering the Bible everywhere. Before 1804 the Bible had been printed and circulated in only fifty languages, by the mid 1800's it was being printed in thousands of languages. No other book approaches the Bible in the number of copies circulated. It is exalted as above all price, as, next to His Son, the most invaluable blessing of God to man. It bears the glorious testimony concerning His Son. Yes; the Scriptures may truly be said to be exalted "to heaven in a cloud", a cloud being an emblem of heavenly elevation.

13 And the same hour was there a great earthquake, and the tenth part of the city fell, and in the earthquake were slain of men seven thousand: and the remnant were affrighted, and gave glory to the God of heaven.

See Revelation 17:18: "The woman which thou saw is that great city which reigneth over the kings (kingdoms) of the earth". That city is the papal Roman power. France is one of the "ten horns" that gave "their power and strength unto the (papal) beast"; it is one of the ten kingdoms that arose out of the Western Empire of Rome, as indicated by the ten toes of Nebuchadnezzar's image. It is also Daniel's ten horned beast of Daniel 7:24. It is John's ten-horned dragon of Revelation 12:3. France, then, was "a tenth part of the city" and was one of the strongest ministers of papal vengeance.



But in the French Revolution it "fell" and with it fell the last civil messenger of papal fury. "And in the earthquake were slain of men seven thousand". France made war, in her revolution of 1789 and onward, on all titles, nobility, priests and pope alike. "And the remnant were affrighted and gave glory to the God of beaver."

"And in the earthquake were slain of men [margin, names of men, or TITLES of men] seven thousand." France made war, in

her revolution of 1789-98 and onward, on all titles of nobility. Nobility and hereditary titles were abolished by the Revolutions of 1789 and 1848. It is said by those who have examined the French records, that just seven thousand titles of men were abolished in that revolution.

"And the remnant were affrighted, and gave glory to the God of heaven." France, in dishonoring God and defying Heaven had filled that nation with such scenes of blood, carnage and horror, as made even the infidels themselves to tremble and stand aghast. The "remnant" that escaped the horrors of that time "gave glory to God". Not willingly, but because God caused this "wrath of man to praise Him" by showing the world that those who make war on heaven, make graves for themselves! Thus glory rebounded to God by the very means that wicked men had employed to tarnish His glory.

The Seventh Trumpet, Third Woe

14 The second woe is past; and, behold, the third woe cometh quickly.

The Islamic power ended August 11, 1840 and the third woe occurs under the next trumpet, the 7th. Then where are we in point of time? "Behold!" that is to say, mark it well, "the third woe cometh quickly". The fearful scenes of the second woe are passed and we are now or soon will be under the sounding of the trumpet that brings the 3rd and last woe. There will be no "peace and safety"; we have a prophetic rendezvous with a 3rd "woe" still to come. More terrible and destructive than any the world has ever witnessed.



15 And the seventh angel sounded; and there were great voices in heaven, saying, The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord, and of His Christ; and He shall reign forever and ever.

16 And the four and twenty elders, which sat before God on their seats, fell upon their faces, and worshipped God,

17 saying, We give thee thanks, O Lord God Almighty, which art, and

was, and art to come; because Thou has taken to Thee Thy great power, and has reigned.

Here the prophet glances forward to the final establishment of the eternal kingdom of God on earth. Although the seventh trumpet has only begun to sound, the voices in heaven and the four and twenty elders anticipate this final event, Gods eternal kingdom, and in heaven they call out and glorify Him!

The seventh trumpet, like the preceding six, covers a period of time, the establishment of His eternal kingdom and the final destruction of all other earthly powers. For it is given to Him whose right it is to reign. Hence this event, to the exclusion of all else, engages the mind of the prophet. In the next verse, John then goes back and takes up events that will happen before this.

18 And the nations were angry, and Thy wrath is come, and the time of the dead, that they should be judged, and that Thou shouldst give reward unto Thy servants the prophets, and to the saints, and them that fear Thy name, small and great; and shouldst destroy them which destroy the earth.

The anger of nations toward one another has been constantly increasing. Jealousy and hatred among nations have been the rule rather than the exception. The wrath of God for the last generation will be filled up in the seven last plagues, Revelation 15:1, which will soon be poured out upon the earth.

"The time of the dead, that they should be judged" is those who now lay in their grave. In this verse it means only the wicked in their graves. They remain there until after the seven last plagues and after the close of the gospel age. A work of judgment, of allotting to each one the punishment that will be due because of his sins. Their punishment due will then be reviewed by the saints in conjunction with Christ during a 1,000 year period of time which begins with the resurrection of the Saints from their grave at the time of His return, 1 Corinthians 6:2; Revelation 20:4.

This judgment of the dead and the living precedes the wrath of God and the seven last plagues, which in turn is followed by Jesus coming in the clouds. And every eye, of those alive on the earth at that time, shall see Him. Wherein, any remaining living wicked are then slain by the brightness of His coming. Thus, this judgment does not concern itself with the saints, but only with the wicked. It refers to a one thousand year period of judgment review upon the wicked; a time during which

the books of records in heaven are carefully considered by the Saints. So that each one may for him or herself conclude that Gods judgment is righteous and true.

A separate judgment, the "investigative judgment" concerns itself only with those who have professed to be followers of the living God and what shall be their reward. The investigative judgment takes place before the wrath of God, the seven last plagues, are poured out. This judgment of the saints is to determine whose *sins* shall be blotted out of the book and whose *name* shall be retained. Some, who professed to be the followers of Christ, will be found wanting. They will not meet the standard and their names will be blotted out from the book of life, while the record of their sins will remain. The investigative judgment began when the 2,300-year prophecy terminated in 1844; it continues today, no man knows the day or hour in which it will be completed. This then is the cleansing of the sanctuary. We are not told when this investigation, which started with Adam, will pass from the dead to the living and then be complete.

Each of us will face our "life record" in one of these two judgment reviews. The life record of the wicked will reveal every evil deed they have ever done. The life record of the saints will show only every good deed they have ever done. It will then be determined for each person, what they're "reward" should be, according to their works. Note that salvation for the Saints is not based on their work. Salvation is a gift warranted only through trusting in the mercy of Christ! Our works will only determine our reward and privileges to be granted to each Saint for eternity. While our works will not save us, it is impossible to be saved without them! Works, correctly understood, are a demonstration, an outworking of our faith. God knows the heart, whether these works are righteous or whether they be for outward show, seeking the accolades of man or merely performed out of fear of losing one's soul. God has not given us the spirit of fear dear friend, He accepts only those works performed in a spirit of love. To "fear God" (reverence Him) is a healthy place to start one's journey of getting to know Him, it will lead to a heart filled with love for His great mercy toward the sinner as one begins to understand his great need of a Savior.


"Thou shouldst give reward unto thy servants the prophets". This refers to all of Gods servants, the Saints, who will be rewarded at the Second Coming of Christ, for He brings their reward with Him, Matthew 16:27; Revelation 22:12. The full reward of the saints, however, is not reached until they enter upon the possession of the new earth, Matthew 25:34.

The punishment of the wicked, "Shouldst destroy them which destroy the earth", refers to the time when all the wicked, who have literally devastated vast regions and wantonly destroyed human life, will be forever devoured by those purifying fires from God out of heaven, 2 Peter 3:7; Revelation 20:9. "Forever" here means the wicked will be destroyed never to return again, sin is eternally eradicated from the Universe. Their destruction is complete, they are burned up root and branch, once and for all time. This should not be confused with the false doctrine of an eternally burning hell fire. God is just, but He is not cruel.

Thus, the seventh trumpet reaches to the end of the one thousand years. Momentous, startling, yet joyous thought! The trumpet now sounding sees the final destruction of the wicked and the saints clothed in a glorious immortality, safely located on the earth made new.

19 And the temple of God was opened in heaven, and there was seen in His temple the ark of His testament: and there were lightnings, and voices, and thunderings, and an earthquake, and great hail.

Once more the prophet carries us back to the beginning of the trumpet. After the introduction of the seventh trumpet in verse 15, the first great event that comes to the mind of John is the transfer of the kingdom from earthly to heavenly rule. God forever crushes the rebellion of this revolted earth; establishes Christ upon His own throne and remains Himself supreme over all. We are next referred back to the state of the nations, the judgment to fall upon them and the final destiny of both saints and sinners in verse 18.



After this field of vision has been scanned, our attention is called back once more in the verse

now under notice, to the close of the priesthood of Christ, the last scene in the work of mercy for a guilty world. The temple is opened, and the second apartment of the sanctuary is entered. We know it is the Holy of Holies that is here opened, for the Ark of the Covenant is seen; and in that apartment alone was the Ark found.

This took place at the end of the 2300 years, when the sanctuary cleansing (judgment) began, Daniel 8:14. At that time the prophetic periods ended and the seventh angel began to sound. Since 1844, the people of God have seen by faith the open door in heaven and the Ark of God's testament within. They are endeavoring to keep every precept of the holy law written upon the tablets deposited there. That the tables of the law are there, just as they were in the Ark in the sanctuary erected by Moses, is evident from the terms which John uses in describing the Ark. He calls it the "Ark of His testament".



The ark was called the Ark of the Covenant, or testament, because it was made for the express purpose of containing the tables of the testimony, the Ten Commandments, Exodus 25:16, 31:18. It was put to no other use, and owed its name solely to the fact that it contained the tables of the law. John, beholding the Ark in heaven affords an unanswerable proof that the law is still there, unaltered in one jot or tittle from the copy which for a time was committed to the care of men in the Ark of the Jewish tabernacle during the time of Moses. From this exposition we see that God's law will stand for eternity.

Those who accept the gospel in this age have received the reed and need to be measuring, that is carefully examining the doctrines, laws, ceremonies, judgments and aspects of the temple, the altar and those that worship therein, Revelation 11:1. They are

uttering their last prophesy before nations, peoples, and tongues, Revelation 10:11. The drama will soon close with the lightnings, thunderings, voices, the earthquake, and great hail, which will constitute nature's last convulsion before all things are made new at the close of the thousand years, Revelation 21:5.








The Sanctuary Mirror

The sanctuary reveals the dividing line between those who are true followers of Christ and those who claim to be following Christ, that "have a form of godliness - but deny the power thereof"



Notice first the mirror. There is a square altar of incense and a square altar of burnt offering. There is a table of shewbread and tables for killing the sacrifice. There is a lamp stand for which no measurements are given and a layer for which no measurements are given.

The five pillars are halfway in the tabernacle (gold pillars, the metal of the tabernacle/heaven) and halfway in the world (brass sockets, the metal of the court/world). Here you have the 10 virgins of Matthew 25. Five are wise/those who live Christianity, and five are foolish/those who claim Christianity but deny the power thereof.

Those who live Christianity

The Wise Arouse From Sleep.--All who wait for the heavenly Bridegroom are represented in the parable as slumbering because their Lord delayed His coming; but the wise roused themselves at the message of His approach, and responded to the message, and their spiritual discernment was not all gone, and they sprang into line. As they took hold of the grace of Christ, their religious experience became vigorous and abundant, and their affections were set upon things above. They discerned where was the source of their supply, and appreciated the love that God had for them. They opened their hearts to receive the Holy Spirit, by which the love of God was shed abroad in their hearts. Their lights were trimmed and burning, and sent forth steady rays into the moral darkness of the world. They glorified God, because they had the oil of grace in their hearts, and did the very work that their Master did before them--went forth to seek and to save those who were lost (ST June 28, 1910). {5BC 1099.7}

Those who claim Christianity

Mat 22:11-14 And when the king came in to see the guests, he saw there a man which had not on a wedding garment: And he saith unto him, Friend, how camest thou in hither not having a wedding garment? And he was speechless. Then said the king to the servants, Bind him hand and foot, and take him away, and cast *him* into outer darkness; there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth. For many are called, but few *are* chosen.


Jesus freely offers his robe of righteousness, (the white border around the court and tabernacle to everyone), but we must choose to wear it, by being changed into his image (the process of sanctification). We must guard our senses because we become like what we behold.

To John was given a measuring reed, "and the angel stood, saying, Rise, and measure the temple of God, and the altar, and them that worship therein." It cannot be comprehended by the finite mind; for it is infinite. "Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God, and keep His commandments: for this is the whole duty of man. For God shall bring every work into judgment, with every secret thing, whether it be good, or whether it be evil." The "reed like unto a rod," with which John was bidden to measure, was the commandments of God.

The prophet was told to measure them that worship in the temple; for the creatures of His hand reflect His image, and are measured by the same standard. Angels worship in that temple, and they reflect the character of Him who is love. There were also men in that temple as worshipers; saints, who, while still on earth, were by faith within the inner veil; and they too were measured by the same reed of His law. Not an outward measure of stature, nor an external weighing of motives, as viewed by the human eye, but character was the test, with the rule of heaven for a standard. The character which is rewarded with a place near the throne is not shallow, but deep; it is not narrow, but broad; and in length it must measure with the life of God. A long experience, a deep experience, a broad experience in divine things, even while living here on earth; this is the life which develops a character that will stand the test of the "measuring reed."

These days are the same as the forty-two months of the preceding verse, and refer to the period of papal triumph. The language of this verse describes the feelings of other nations besides the one committing the outrage on the witnesses. They would see what war infidel France had made on the Bible, but would not be led nationally to engage in the wicked work, nor suffer the murdered witnesses to be buried, or put out of sight among themselves, though they lay dead three days and a half, that is, three years and a half, in France. No; this very attempt on the part of France served to arouse Christians everywhere to put forth new exertions in behalf of the Bible, as we shall presently see.

(*Zech 4:2-3*) These seven branches receive their oil from a single bowl, and the oil for this bowl is supplied by two olive trees, one on either side. The purity of the oil they burn is represented by the close connection with living, growing trees. This oil is the oil of grace, the truth of God.

The unity of the seven candlesticks is typified by the common bowl from which each gains its supply of oil. How beautiful a picture of the work of God's Word in ministering to the needs of the church on earth. Life flows from the Old as well as the New Testament to those whose hearts are open channels for the Spirit. When connection with the living trees is severed, spiritual death is the result. The lights may burn for a time, but they soon exhaust the supply in the bowl, and gradually the flame dies out.

Extinguishing a light does not effect the olive trees. Indeed they are trees of life, guarded by flaming swords, like the tree of life in the garden of Eden after the fall; and the flashes of light destroy the life of those who lift a hand against the witnesses. Men may claim to receive light, independently of these witnesses; but there are no channels for the communication of the spirit of wisdom and knowledge, except these two trees, or some of their branches, through which the life, the golden oil, is constantly flowing.

It is thus that **they have power to stay the heavens that it rain not.** It is for this reason that the **three and a half years of drought in the days of Elijah** are used by the divine historian to illustrate the **three and one-half prophetic years, the twelve hundred and sixty years of darkness, brought about by severing the connection between the church and the two witnesses**. When the connection was broken the restraining power of God was withdrawn; and as in the natural world, so in the spiritual, there was nothing to prevent bloodshed, famine, and persecution. **The time of great persecution was the period during which the witnesses prophesied covered with sackcloth.** The Reformation removed the sackcloth from the two witnesses. (*Rev 11:5-6*) 195-197 Seer of Patmos, Stephen Haskell

In regard to the third angel's message, what type of unity did our pioneers seek verses the unity of unbelievers and what steps did they take to accomplish this?

The very same course was taken by the denominational churches when we embraced the first and second angels' messages. And as the light was shining forth from the oracles of God upon the messages which were present truth for our time, Satan tried by every means in his power to close the door to shut out the light. We had to meet with prejudice and with \ridicule and with sneers and with criticism of the very same character that we have had to meet here in this conference. The opposition seemed almost crushing in its influence. What if we had held our peace and been controlled by the ministers who thought we were heretics, disturbing the peace of churches? Nevertheless, we did move forward, and while many bent beneath the power of opposition and yielded their faith to preserve the unity with their brethren and retained their place in the churches, many could not conscientiously do this. They held fast their faith. And what was the result? They

At the present time, when the end of all things earthly is rapidly approaching, <u>Satan is putting forth</u> <u>desperate efforts to ensuare the world</u>. <u>He is devising many plans to occupy minds, and to divert attention from the truths essential to salvation</u>.... {Ev 705.3}

The theme of greatest importance is the third angel's message, embracing the messages of the first and second angels. All should understand the truths contained in these messages and demonstrate them in daily life, for this is essential to salvation. We shall have to study earnestly, prayerfully, in order to understand these grand truths; and our power to learn and comprehend will be taxed to the utmost.--Letter 97, 1902. {Ev 196.1}

God may bear long while the account goes on; calls to repentance and offers of pardon may be given; yet a time will come when the account will be full, when the soul's decision will have been made, when by his own choice man's destiny will have been fixed?

<u>already given</u>. The messages of <u>Revelation 14</u> are those by which the world is to be





Christ came into our world to sway back the powers of darkness and dispel the powers of the enemy. There he comes pretending to


be an angel of light, and he says, If You will fall down and worship me I will give You all the

How do we disgrace the truth; the most solemn message ever imparted to mortals?

Commence anew. Christians professing to believe the most solemn message ever imparted to mortals were seeking a quarrel with each other like little children. You disgrace the truth. Worldlings are more consistent. There is a lack of principle with some of the professed people of God, a great lack of forbearance and patience with each other, which places them all in almost a hopeless condition. Instead of trying to be united and not noticing little things unworthy of a moment's thought, they give way to evil propensities. And because things do not go just exactly to suit your minds, you find fault, hate and despise each other. You tempt the devil to tempt you. {Lt12-1861.5}

Instead of working towards unity, we disgrace the truth.

We need to cooperate and work towards answering the prayer of Christ to have the truth accompanied with power. What continual efforts should we make towards this goal?

If all who have influence felt the necessity of co-operation and would seek to answer the prayer of Christ, that they may be one as He is one with the Father, the cause of present truth would be a power upon this coast. But the people of God are asleep, and do not see the wants of the cause for this time. They do not feel the importance of concentrated action. Satan is ever seeking to divide the faith and hearts of God's people. He well knows that union

is their strength, and division their weakness. It is important and essential that all of Christ's followers understand Satan's

devices and <u>with a <u>united</u> front meet his attacks and vanquish him. They need to <u>make continual efforts to press together</u> even if it be at some sacrifice to themselves. {3T 434.4}</u>

How Discord & Dissension is Produced

As we approach the last crisis, it is of vital moment that harmony and unity exist among the Lord's instrumentalities. The world is filled with storm and war and variance. Yet under one head—the papal power—the people will unite to oppose God in the person of His witnesses. This union is cemented by the great apostate. While he seeks to unite his agents in warring against the truth he will work to divide and scatter its advocates. Jealousy, evil surmising, evil speaking, are instigated by him to produce discord and dissension. The members of Christ's church have the power to thwart the purpose of the adversary of souls. At such a time as this let them not be found at variance with one another or with any of the Lord's workers. Amidst the general discord let there be one place where harmony and unity exist because the Bible is made the guide of life. What will be the ambitions of the righteous, the one absorbing question that will answer the prayer of Christ?

and feeling, and trample upon the prayer of Christ as though the unity for which he prayed was unessential, that there is no necessity for his followers to be one, even as he is one with the Father. They go off on a tangent, and Jehu-like, call to their brethren to follow their example of zeal for the Lord. If their zeal led them to work in the same lines in which their brethren who have carried the heat and burden of the day, are working; if they were as persevering to overcome discouragements and obstacles as their brethren have been, they might well be imitated, and God would accept them. But men are to be condemned who start out with a proclamation of wonderful light, and yet draw away from the agents whom God is leading. This was the way in which Korah, Dathan, and Abiram did, and their action is recorded as a warning to all others. We are not to do as they have done,—accuse and condemn those upon whom God has laid the burden of the work. {RH September 12, 1893, par. 6}

The Lord wants that every one of us should have sanctified ears, that we should have a sanctified understanding, that Jesus Christ may move upon our minds, that it may affect our hearts and our characters so that we shall be just what He wants us to be. And what is that? Representatives of Jesus Christ in the world. What is that? What it is to be a light amid the moral darkness that prevails? It is to be a light wherever we are. A light—not to have a light and chaffy spirit—that is not the kind, because that is from beneath. But we want solidity of character. More than that, we want to know what faith is. We

want to know what it is to love one another. And if we draw nigh to God, individually, then don't you see what the result will be? Can't you see that we will draw nigh to one another? We cannot draw nigh to God and come to the same cross without our hearts being blended together in perfect unity, answering

the prayer of Christ "that they may be one," as He is one with the Father. [John 17:11.] And therefore we should seek in spirit, in understanding, in faith, that we may be one, that God may be glorified in us as He is glorified in the Son; and that God shall love us as He loves the Son. Do you think God will love us if He sees us here right in the very last close of this earth's history, that we are quibbling and trifling and spreading ourselves apart as far as we can, for fear that we shall have an understanding with some of our brethren? Do you suppose that that honors God? I tell you, Nay. God desires and designs that His children shall be one as Christ is one with the Father. {Ms7-1890.6}





The Three Angels

The third angel's message is to be earnest, decided manner. The trumpet [7th trumpet/ 3rd woe- Islam] is to give a certain sound. {Ms16-1900.23}

Rev 14:9 And the third angel followed them, saying with a loud voice, If any man worship the beast and his image, and receive [his] mark in his forehead, or in his hand, 14:10 The same shall drink of the wine of the wrath [plagues of Islam] of God, which is poured out without mixture into the cup of his indignation; and he shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels, and in the presence of the Lamb: 14:11 And the smoke of their torment ascendeth up for ever and ever: and they have no rest day nor night, who worship the beast and his image, and whosoever receiveth the mark of his name.

What danger are we in - in regard to the third angel's message?

The third angel's message is to be given with power. The power of the proclamation of the first and second messages is to be intensified in the third. In the Revelation John says of the heavenly messenger who unites with the third angel: "I saw another angel come down from heaven, having great power; and the earth was lightened with his glory. And he cried mightily with a strong voice." Revelation 18:1, 2. We are in danger of giving the third angel's message in so indefinite a manner that it does not impress the people. So many other interests are brought in that the very message which should be proclaimed with power becomes tame and voiceless. At our camp meetings a mistake has been made. The Sabbath question has been touched upon, but has not been presented as the great test for this time. While the churches profess to believe in Christ, they are violating the law which Christ Himself proclaimed from Sinai. The Lord bids us: "Show My people their transgression, and the house of Jacob their sins." Isaiah 58:1. The trumpet is to give a certain sound. {6T 60.1}

We are to show the errors taught - connected to the three angel's messages that have been entering the church since 1844.

I saw <u>another mighty angel</u> [4th angel- Rev 18:1-2] commissioned to descend to earth, and <u>unite his voice with the third angel</u>, and give power and force to his message. Great power and glory were imparted to the angel, and as he descended, <u>the earth was lightened with his glory</u>. The light which went before and followed after this angel, penetrated every where, as <u>he</u>

cried mightily, with a strong voice, saying, Babylon the great is fallen, is fallen, and is become the habitation of

devils, and the hold of every foul spirit, and a cage of every unclean and hateful bird. The message of the fall of Babylon, as given by the second angel [of Rev 14:8], is again given, with the addition of the corruptions which have been entering the churches since 1844. The work of this angel comes in at the right time, and joins in the last great work of the third angel's message, as it swells into a loud cry. {1SG 193.2}




Regarding the prophecy of Habakkuk that was published the day before Sister White passed away on July 16, 1915:

Habakkuk

Let us ever hold in remembrance the cheering message, "The vision is yet for an appointed time, but at the end it shall speak, and not lie: though it tarry, wait for it; because it will surely

come, it will not tarry.... The just shall live by his faith." Habakkuk 2:3, 4. {RH July 15, 1915, par. 3}



Interesting to note that in the 1884 Great Controversy, in the Chapter entitled, "Snares of Satan", Sister White exposes our adversary's plot of deceptions to keep mankind in darkness. And one way he does this is through rejecting the truths on Habakkuk's tables (1843 & 1850 charts)! She quotes Habakkuk 2:2. 3!:



Says the great deceiver: "I will have upon the ground, as my agents, men holding false doctrines mingled with just enough truth to deceive souls. I will also have unbelieving ones present, who will express doubts in regard to the Lord's messages of warning to his church. Should the people read and believe these admonitions, we could have little hope of overcoming them. But if we can divert their attention from these warnings, they will remain ignorant of our power and cunning, and we shall secure them in our ranks at last. God will not permit his words to be slighted with impunity. If we can keep souls deceived for a time, God's mercy will be withdrawn, and he will give them up to our full control. {4SP 340.2}

In order to sustain erroneous doctrines or unchristian practices, they seize upon passages of Scripture separated from the context, perhaps quoting half of a single verse as proving their point, when the remaining portion

would show the meaning to be quite the opposite. With the cunning of the serpent, they entrench themselves behind disconnected utterances construed to suit their carnal desires. Thus do many willfully pervert the word of God. Others, who have an active imagination, seize upon the figures and symbols of Holy Writ, interpret to suit their fancy, with little regard to the testimony of Scripture as its own interpreter, and then they present their vagaries as the teachings of God's word. {4SP 343.3} Sister White, next, connects the visions of Daniel, John and Habakkuk:


<u>The Bible</u> was designed to be a guide to all who wish to become acquainted with the will of their Maker. God gave to men the <u>sure word of prophecy</u>; angels and even <u>Christ himself came to make known to Daniel and John the things that must shortly come to pass</u>. <u>Those important matters that concern our salvation were not left involved in mystery</u>. They were not revealed in such a way as to perplex and mislead the honest seeker after truth. Said the Lord by the prophet Habakkuk, "<u>Write the vision, and make it plain upon tables, that he may run that readeth it.</u>" [Habakkuk 2:2, 3.] The word of God is plain to all who study it



with a prayerful heart. Every truly honest soul will come to the light of truth. "Light is sown for the righteous." [Psalm 97:11.] No church can advance in holiness unless its members are earnestly seeking for truth as for hid treasure. (4SP 344.2) 1884 GC

How much zeal should we have for the truth?

Those temptations are most dangerous which come from the professed servants of God, and from our friends. When persons who are uniting with the world, yet claiming great piety and love, counsel the faithful workers for God to be less zealous and more conservative, our answer must be an appeal to the word of God. When they plead for union with those who have been our determined opposers, we should fear and shun them as decidedly as did Nehemiah. Those who would lead away from the old landmarks to



After the Great Disappointment there were few who set themselves to seek the Word with all their heart. But some souls would not settle down in discouragement and deny that the Lord had led them. To these the truth was opened point by point, and entwined with their most hallowed recollections and sympathies. . . . Truth was made to shine forth, beautiful in its simplicity, dignified with a power and invested with an assurance unknown before the Disappointment. We could then proclaim the message in unity. (Manuscript Release No. 1237)

What standard will bring us into unity?

The professedly Christian world many turn away from the plain teachings of the Bible and build up a creed from human speculations and pleasing fables, and they point to their tower as a way to climb up to heaven. Men hang with admiration upon the lips of

eloquence while it teaches that the transgressor shall not die, that salvation may be secured without obedience to the law of God. If the professed followers of Christ would accept God's standard, it would bring them into unity; but so long as human wisdom is exalted above His Holy Word, there will be divisions and dissension. The existing confusion of conflicting creeds and sects is fitly represented by the term "Babylon," which prophecy (Revelation 14:8; 18:2) applies to the world-loving churches of the last days. {PP 124.1}



Separate from those teaching errors—deadly poison to the soul—God displeased when we listen to error

I was shown the necessity of those who believe that we are having the last message of mercy, being separate from those who are daily imbibing new errors. I saw that neither young nor old should attend their meetings; for it is wrong to thus



encourage them while they teach error that is a <u>deadly poison</u> to the soul and teach for doctrines the commandments of men. The influence of such gatherings is not good. If God has delivered us from such darkness and error, we should stand fast in the liberty wherewith He has set us free and rejoice in the truth. <u>God</u> is displeased with us when we go to listen to error, without being obliged to go:

for <u>unless He sends us to those meetings</u> where error is forced home to the people by the power of the will, He will not keep us. The angels cease their watchful care over us, and we are left to the buffetings of the enemy, to be darkened and weakened by him and the power of his evil angels; and the light around us becomes contaminated with the darkness. {EW 124.3}

The FAHERHOOD of God is given to us in the gift of Jesus Christ; and as God was one with His only begot ten Son, so He would have His earthly children one with him. {RH Sept 30, 1909}

The personality of the Father and the Son, also the unity that exists between Them, are <u>presented in the seventeenth chapter of John, in the prayer of Christ for His disciples</u>: {MH 421.7}

Neither pray I for these alone, but for them also which shall believe on Me through their word; that they all may be **one**; as Thou, Father, art in Me, and I in Thee, that they also may be **one** in Us: that the world may believe that Thou hast sent Me." John 17:20, 21. {MH 421.8}

The unity that exists <u>between</u> Christ and His disciples does not destroy the personality of either. They are one <u>in purpose</u>, <u>in mind</u>, <u>in character</u>, but not in person. It is thus that God and Christ are one. {MH 422.1} {8T 269.4}

In this scripture (*John 17:20, 21*) God and Christ are spoken of separately. They are two distinct persons, but one <u>in mind</u>, one <u>in heart</u>, one <u>in holiness and justice</u>, <u>and purity</u>, and one <u>in the work of seeking</u> to save the sinful race. {BCL 127.3} {NL 124}

Christ the Word, the Only Begotten of God, was **one** with the eternal Father,— **one** <u>in nature</u>, <u>in character</u>, and <u>in purpose</u>,—the only being in all the universe that could enter into all the counsels and <u>purposes</u> of God. {GC 493.1}

From eternity there was a **complete unity** between the Father and the Son. They were two, yet little short of being identical; **two in individuality**, yet **one in spirit**, **and heart**, **and character**. {YI December 16, 1897, par. 5}

The Jews had never before heard such words from human lips, and a convicting influence attended them; for it seemed that divinity flashed through humanity as Jesus said, "I and my Father are one." The words of Christ were full of deep meaning as he put forth the claim that he and the Father were of one substance, possessing the same attributes. {ST November 27, 1893, par. 5}

Let them be thankful to God for His manifold mercies and be kind to one another. They have **one** God and **one** Saviour; and **one** Spirit--the Spirit of Christ--is to bring **unity** into their ranks. {E.G. White, Testimonies Volume 9, p. 189} 1909

QUESTIONS AND THOUGHTS TO CONSIDER--

There must be no long discussions, no presenting of new theories in regard to prophecies that God has already made plain. The great work from which the mind should not be diverted is the consideration of our personal standing in the sight of God. Are our feet on the Rock of Ages? Are we hiding ourselves in the only Refuge? The storm is coming, relentless in its fury. Are we prepared to meet it? Are we one with Christ as he is one with the Father? Are we heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ? Are we working in co-partnership with the Saviour? {RH November 27, 1900, par. 13}

Men are taking sides, according to their choice. Those that are feeding on the word of God will show this by their practise; they are on the Lord's side, seeking by precept and example to reform the world. All that have refused to be taught of God, hold the traditions of men. They at last pass over on the side of the enemy, against God, and are written, "antichrist." The people of God, who understand our position in this world's history, are, with ears open and hearts softened and subdued, pressing together in unity—one with Jesus Christ. Those who will not practise the lessons of Christ, but keep themselves in hand to mold themselves, find in antichrist the center of their union. While the two parties stand in collision, the Lord will appear, and shine before his ancients gloriously. He will set up a kingdom that shall stand forever. {SpTA09 55.2}

Are we willing to put forth such efforts to save our fellow-men as Christ made for our salvation? Will we manifest such regard for the reputation and interest of our brethren as Jesus has taught us by his care for us? We are one in Christ. In his sight, the bond that unites believers is more sacred and enduring than any other tie. Christ is the Vine; we are branches, and only branches. This view of our relationship to him and to one another should lead us to labor earnestly for the salvation of our brethren. We must be faithful to do our appointed work, to reprove, rebuke, exhort, with all long-suffering and doctrine. This must be done in the spirit of meekness, while abiding in Christ. Here is our power over hearts. When Christ reigns in the hearts, selfishness will die out, and disinterested benevolence take its place. Coldness and indifference will then be considered as fatal as for a sentinel to sleep at his post, thus exposing the whole army to defeat and death. We must ever be on our guard. Our enemy is vigilant; he is ever watching for opportunities to come in with his snares. {RH March 4, 1884, par. 8}

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
