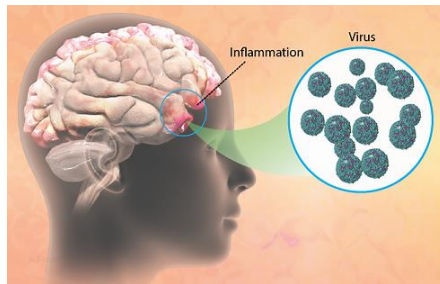


BRAIN, INFLAMMATION OF THE.

In this disease, the membranes only may be inflamed, which is generally the case, or the substance of the brain only, or both. So far as treatment is concerned, it matters not which part is inflamed, for the treatment is the same in either case.

This disease is essentially the same as that already described as brain fever, the only difference being that in this there is less inflammation and less fever, consequently the symptoms are less violent.

Treatment.—See Brain Fever, and treat as there directed.
