**Crucifixion and Resurrection of Christ - A.D. 31**

## **Book of Matthew Written in A.D. 39 (8 years after the resurrection of Christ):**

"In the **end of the sabbath** (*7<sup>th</sup> day of the week*), as it began to dawn toward the **first day of the week** (*Sunday*), came Mary Magdalene and the other Mary to see the sepulchre." ~Matthew 28:1 (*Italics added for emphasis & clarity*)

## **Book of Mark Written A.D. 43 (12 years after the resurrection of Christ):**

"And when **the sabbath was past** (*7<sup>th</sup> day of the week*), Mary Magdalene, and Mary the mother of James, and Salome, had bought sweet spices, that they might come and anoint him. And very early in the morning **the first day of the week** (*Sunday*), they came unto the sepulchre at the rising of the sun." ~Mark 16:1-2 (*Italics added for emphasis & clarity*)

## **Book of Luke and Galatians Written A.D. 56 (25 years after the resurrection of Christ):**

"And they returned, and prepared spices and ointments; and **rested the sabbath day** (*7<sup>th</sup> day of the week*) **according to the commandment** (*Gen 2:1-3; Ex 20:8-11;16:25-30*)." ~Luke 23:56 (*Italics added for emphasis & clarity*)

"Then arose Peter, and ran unto the sepulchre; and stooping down, he beheld the linen clothes laid by themselves, and departed, wondering in himself at that which was come to pass. And, behold, two of them went **that same day** (*Sunday*) to a village called Emmaus, which was from Jerusalem about threescore furlongs." ~Luke 24:13 (*Italics added for emphasis & clarity*)

## **Book of John Written A.D. 96 (65 years after the resurrection of Christ):**

"**The first day of the week** (*Sunday*) cometh Mary Magdalene early, when it was yet dark (*the Sabbath was past; see Gen 1:5, 8, 13, 19, 23, 31;2:1-3*), unto the sepulchre, and seeth the stone taken away from the sepulchre." ~John 20:1 (*Italics added for emphasis & clarity*)

## **Book of Acts Written A.D. 63 (32 years after the resurrection of Christ):**

"But when they departed from Perga, they came to Antioch in Pisidia, and **went into the synagogue** (*church*) **on the sabbath day** (*7<sup>th</sup> day of the week*), and **sat down**. ... And when the Jews were gone out of the synagogue, the Gentiles besought that these words might be preached to them **the next sabbath**. ... And **the next sabbath day** came almost the whole city together to hear the word of God." ~Acts 13:14, 42, 44 (*Italics added for emphasis & clarity*)

"And **on the sabbath** we went out of the city by a river side, where prayer was wont to be made; and we sat down, and spake unto the women which resorted thither." ~Acts 16:13

"And Paul, **as his manner was**, went in unto them, and **three sabbath days** reasoned with them out of the scriptures," ~Acts 17:2

**Crucifixion and Resurrection of Christ - A.D. 31**

## **Book of Matthew Written in A.D. 39 (8 years after the resurrection of Christ):**

"In the **end of the sabbath** (*7<sup>th</sup> day of the week*), as it began to dawn toward the **first day of the week** (*Sunday*), came Mary Magdalene and the other Mary to see the sepulchre." ~Matthew 28:1 (*Italics added for emphasis & clarity*)

## **Book of Mark Written A.D. 43 (12 years after the resurrection of Christ):**

"And when **the sabbath was past** (*7<sup>th</sup> day of the week*), Mary Magdalene, and Mary the mother of James, and Salome, had bought sweet spices, that they might come and anoint him. And very early in the morning **the first day of the week** (*Sunday*), they came unto the sepulchre at the rising of the sun." ~Mark 16:1-2 (*Italics added for emphasis & clarity*)

## **Book of Luke and Galatians Written A.D. 56 (25 years after the resurrection of Christ):**

"And they returned, and prepared spices and ointments; and **rested the sabbath day** (*7<sup>th</sup> day of the week*) **according to the commandment** (*Gen 2:1-3; Ex 20:8-11;16:25-30*)." ~Luke 23:56 (*Italics added for emphasis & clarity*)

"Then arose Peter, and ran unto the sepulchre; and stooping down, he beheld the linen clothes laid by themselves, and departed, wondering in himself at that which was come to pass. And, behold, two of them went **that same day** (*Sunday*) to a village called Emmaus, which was from Jerusalem about threescore furlongs." ~Luke 24:13 (*Italics added for emphasis & clarity*)

## **Book of John Written A.D. 96 (65 years after the resurrection of Christ):**

"**The first day of the week** (*Sunday*) cometh Mary Magdalene early, when it was yet dark (*the Sabbath was past; see Gen 1:5, 8, 13, 19, 23, 31;2:1-3*), unto the sepulchre, and seeth the stone taken away from the sepulchre." ~John 20:1 (*Italics added for emphasis & clarity*)

## **Book of Acts Written A.D. 63 (32 years after the resurrection of Christ):**

"But when they departed from Perga, they came to Antioch in Pisidia, and **went into the synagogue** (*church*) **on the sabbath day** (*7<sup>th</sup> day of the week*), and **sat down**. ... And when the Jews were gone out of the synagogue, the Gentiles besought that these words might be preached to them **the next sabbath**. ... And **the next sabbath day** came almost the whole city together to hear the word of God." ~Acts 13:14, 42, 44 (*Italics added for emphasis & clarity*)

"And **on the sabbath** we went out of the city by a river side, where prayer was wont to be made; and we sat down, and spake unto the women which resorted thither." ~Acts 16:13

"And Paul, **as his manner was**, went in unto them, and **three sabbath days** reasoned with them out of the scriptures," ~Acts 17:2

**Book of 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> John Written A.D. 98 (67 years after the resurrection of Christ):**

"And hereby we do know that we know him, if we keep his commandments. He that saith, I know him, and keepeth not his commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him. **But whoso keepeth his word, in him verily is the love of God perfected:** hereby know we that we are in him. He that saith he abideth in him ought himself also so to walk, even as he walked. Brethren, I write no new commandment unto you, but an old commandment which ye had from the beginning. **The old commandment** (4<sup>th</sup> Commandment contains command to rest on Sabbath-Exodus 20:8-11) **is the word which ye have heard from the beginning. ... Whosoever committeth sin transgresseth also the law: for sin is the transgression of the law.**" ~1 John 2:3-7; 3:4 (Italics added for emphasis & clarity)

**Book of Romans, 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians Written A.D. 57 (26 years after the resurrection of Christ):**

"Therefore by the deeds of the law there shall no flesh be justified in his sight: for by the law is the knowledge of sin." ~Romans 3:20

**Book of Ephesians, Hebrews and Colossians Written A.D. 62 (31 years after the resurrection of Christ):**

"For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, saith the Lord; **I will put my laws into their mind, and write them in their hearts:** and I will be to them a God, and they shall be to me a people:" ~Hebrews 8:10 (See Ezekiel 36:26, 27)

**Book of Timothy, Titus and 2Peter Written A.D. 63 (32 years after the resurrection of Christ)**

"For it had been better for them not to have known **the way of righteousness**, than, after they have known it, **to turn from the holy commandment** (see verse 14) delivered unto them." ~2 Peter 2:21 (See Proverbs 12:28; 28:9-19; Psalms 119:142; 2 Chronicles 7:19, 20)

**Book of Revelation Written A.D. 94 (63 years after the resurrection of Christ):**

"Blessed are they that **do his commandments**, that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city." ~Revelation 22:14 (See Revelation 12:17; 14:12; Deuteronomy 9:5-8; 10:13; 28:9)

"Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: **Fear God, and keep his commandments: for this is the whole duty of man.**"  
~Ecclesiastes 12:13 (See Deuteronomy 8:6; 13:4,17-18; 15:5)
